ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Candidates who have successfully completed B.A. in Education (Honours/Major) with a minimum of 55% marks in the Honours papers (45% in the Honours papers for the reserved category).
- Candidates who have successfully completed B.Ed. / M.Ed. with a minimum of 55% marks (45% for Reserved Categories).
- B.A. in Education (Honours/Major) candidates who have completed 2nd year or 5th Semester and are awaiting final year / 6th semester Examination Results are also eligible to apply. Admission for such candidates will be provisional and be conditional to their passing the qualifying examination with the minimum required marks (55% marks in Honours papers, 45% marks for Reserved Categories).
- B.Ed. / M.Ed. candidates who have completed 1st year or 3rd Semester and are awaiting final year / 4th semester Examination Results are also eligible to apply. Admission for such candidates will be provisional and be conditional to their passing the qualifying examination with the minimum required marks (55% marks in Honours papers, 45% marks for Reserved Categories).
- No candidate shall be eligible for admission after a lapse of more than five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. The year of admission will not be taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.
- At the time of application, the candidate must not have any arrear or failed papers from the previous years or semesters.
- Noncompliance with the eligibility criteria will lead to rejection of the application.

THERE WILL BE AN ADMISSION TEST AND THE SELECTION WILL BE ON THE BASIS OF ADMISSION TEST MARKS. ADMISSION TEST DATES AND OTHER DETAILS WILL BE ANNOUNCED LATER. PLEASE CHECK THE ADMISSION SECTION OF THE COLLEGE WEBSITE FOR UPDATES.

- If a student fails to comply with the above norms, the admission will be cancelled and the student will have to withdraw, and no fees will be refunded.
