St. Xavier's College, Kolkata has started a rural campus at Raghapur, 20km from its Mother Teresa Sarani (City) campus, in Bishnupur constituency of South 24-Parganas, West Bengal

Two buildings with a total of 1,05,000sqft is equipped with all infrastructure facilities like classrooms, library, computer lab, offices, canteen etc. Classes began from the academic session 2014-15.

The Raghapur campus is the "rural image" of St. Xavier's College and it is a bold step taken by the Calcutta Jesuits keeping in mind the "option for the poor" policy.

5. BA. Honours in **Political Science** with Human Rights, History and Bengali as ancillary subjects
6. MA. **Bengali**

General Guidelines

1. Medium of instruction is in Bengali & English
2. The residential address of the candidate is preferably within a distance of 15km from the Raghapur Campus or the resident of South 24 Parganas District, candidates from other areas also eligible..
3. Reservation rules for admission: as per SXC norm.
4. Compulsory languages: Bengali and English.
5. College hours:
 - a. Office hours: 9:00 am to 4:30 pm.
 - b. Class hours: 10.30 am to 4 pm.

Environmental Studies (100 marks), Compulsory Languages (100+100 marks) and Foundation Courses (50+50 marks) are common for all students.

Eligibility Criteria

- Minimum percentage of marks for application to Honours courses - 60%.
- Minimum percentage of marks for application for S.C., S.T. and Christians: 55%.
- The student must have passed in all the papers as per the respective board/council pass marks.
- The student must have obtained 45% marks in each of the 4 subjects included in the aggregate calculation.

- **Eligible candidates who fulfill the required admission criteria, will be allowed to take SPOT ADMISSION.**
- **Admission process will begin soon after the publication of WBHS results.**
- **Students can also apply online by uploading the required documents mentioned on our website for admission. Students who wish to apply online need to upload their documents on the email id: stxavier_rgpadmission@sxccal.edu**

No candidate shall be eligible for admission after a lapse of more than **five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination**. The year of admission will not be taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

For admission to all courses other than Bengali Honours, a student must have studied and passed in English in the +2 level. Admission of students failing in English or not having English will be cancelled (excluding the foreign students for whom there is a separate set of rules).

UG Honours/General courses and Integrated Masters courses:

- Aggregate is calculated with 4 subjects at +2 level including the compulsory subjects as indicated in the eligibility criteria for application and the subjects having the maximum marks from the rest of the subjects.
- The following subjects **must not be included** in the calculation of aggregate:

- Every applicant must fulfill the eligibility criteria as laid down for each course.
- **The student must have obtained 45% marks in each of the 4 subjects included in the aggregate calculation.**
- **The student must have passed in all the papers as per the respective board/council pass marks.**
- Marks in all subjects indicated in the +2 level marksheet must be entered in the application form.
- Students passing the GCE examination of the UK are eligible for admission only if they have passed with 2 'A' Levels and 3 'O' levels. Only subjects passed at A-level can be taken as Honours. Only subjects passed at 'A' level can be considered as compulsory as per the individual course eligibility criteria. **Such candidates must have completed and passed the 'A' level examination at the time of application. Candidates with projected mark sheets are not eligible.**
- **Foreign Nationals need to produce their English Proficiency certificate (TOEFL, IELTS) if the instruction of study in the qualifying examination is not in English medium. Students without TOEFL, IELTS are not eligible to apply.**

The College reserves the right to reject the candidature and/or cancel the application/ admission at any stage, if an applicant fails to fulfill the above conditions.
