ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Candidates who have successfully completed B.A. in Education with a minimum of 55% marks in the Honours papers (45% in the Honours papers for the reserved category).

Such candidates shall not be eligible for admission after a lapse of more than five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination. The year of admission will not be taken into account while calculating five years from the year of passing the previous qualifying examination.

OR

Candidates who have successfully completed M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. with a minimum of 55% marks (50% marks for Reserved Categories) and have **also** successfully completed B.Ed. with a minimum of 60 % marks (55 % for Reserved Categories).

Such candidates should not be more than 45 years old as on July 01, 2023.

- B.A. in Education (Honours) candidates who have completed 2nd year or 5th Semester and are awaiting final year / 6th semester Examination Results are also eligible to apply. Admission for such candidates will be provisional and be conditional to their passing the qualifying examination with the minimum required marks [55% for General and 45% for Reserved category].
- B.Ed. candidates completing M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. and who have completed 1st year or 3rd Semester and are awaiting final year / 4th semester Examination Results of M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. are also eligible to apply. Admission for such candidates will be provisional and be conditional to their passing the qualifying examination with the minimum required marks [(M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. 55% for General and 50% for Reserved category) and (B.Ed. 60 % marks for General Candidates and 55 % marks for Reserved Categories)].
- M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. candidates completing B.Ed. and who have completed 1st year or 3rd Semester and are awaiting final year / 4th semester Examination Results of B.Ed. are also eligible to apply. Admission for such candidates will be provisional and be conditional to their passing the qualifying examination with the minimum required marks [(M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. 55% for General and 50% for Reserved category) and (B.Ed. 60 % marks for General Candidates and 55 % marks for Reserved Categories)].
- At the time of application, the candidate must not have any arrear or failed papers from the previous years or semesters.
- Noncompliance with the eligibility criteria will lead to rejection of the application.

- In all other cases for candidates completing B.A. in Education with Honours, enter your marks up to the last semester / year result published in your University / College.


❖ For Candidates with a B.Ed. completing/completed M.A./M.Sc./M.Com.:

- If your final result in M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. has been published, then enter both B.Ed. and M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. marks accordingly.
- In all other cases for candidates completing M.A./M.Sc./M.Com., enter your B.Ed. marks and marks up to the last semester / year result of M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. published in your University / College.

❖ For Candidates with a M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. completing/completed B.Ed.:

- If your final result in B.Ed. has been published, then enter both M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. and B.Ed. marks accordingly.
- In all other cases for candidates completing B.Ed., enter your M.A./M.Sc./M.Com. marks and marks up to the last semester / year result of B.Ed. published in your University / College.
